July 1

Deadline for faculty member to notify Department Chair in writing of intent to stand for promotion.

August 1

Deadline for faculty member to provide Department Chair with the following materials:

September 1

(Clinical Departments Only)

Deadline for Clinical Department Chairs to provide the College of Medicine Office of Clinical Affairs with their own letter of recommendation, and completed promotion packets. For more information, contact:

October 1

Deadline for Departments and/or Office of Clinical Affairs to submit completed dossiers and promotion packets to the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs (Faculty Affairs) for consideration by the College of Medicine (COM) Non-Tenure Track Faculty Appointments and Promotions Committee.

November 1

Deadline for COM Non-Tenure Track Faculty Appointments and Promotions Committee to forward their recommendations to the Dean (a copy of the committee’s recommendations is also sent to Department Chairs).

March

Final consideration for all faculty promotion recommendations by the NEOMED Board of Trustees.

July 1

Annual effective date for all approved faculty promotions.
